"What is Polenta Made Of? Polenta is made of simply two ingredients: cornmeal and chicken broth. But there are countless ways to enhance the flavors with other ingredients such as: onions, garlic, butter, cream, cheese, and herbs."

Ingredients:

- 4 cups low-sodium chicken broth
- 1 cup fine cornmeal
- 4 tbsp unsalted butter
- 1 1/2 cups finely grated Parmigiano Reggiano (packed)
- salt and pepper to taste

EASY PEASEY CHEESEY POLENTA

Instructions:

- Bring chicken broth to a boil over medium-high heat.
- · Very slowly whisk in the cornmeal a little at a time making sure to work out any lumps before adding more.
- Turn heat to low and continue to stir with a wooden spoon for another 10 minutes or until mixture will just hold a shape but is not overly firm. It should be the texture of soft mashed potatoes. Not runny but not firm either.
- Stir in butter and then Parmigiano Reggiano. Stir until cheese is melted and fully incorporated.
- Add salt and pepper to taste.
- Serve immediately or pour into flat dish and cool until firm.

Note

Serve alongside a meat or vegetable ragu or meatballs with tomato sauce. Alternatively, you can also pour the mixture into a flat 9x9 baking dish and let it cool until it becomes firm. Then cut into squares and top with tomato sauce and cheese, sauteed mushrooms or vegetables, and serve as an appetizer.
